WILL Data Format Specification

The WILL Data Format Specification describes a data format used to input, output, and exchange digital ink data among diverse products and applications on multiple platforms. Wacom Co., Ltd. (“Wacom”) owns patented technology disclosed in the WILL Data Format Specification. We offer this patent license (the “License”) to all individuals and organizations in the world under the following terms and conditions in order to encourage the use of digital-ink data in the WILL Data Format.

Public License

Wacom grants every individual and organization in the world the right, under all Essential Claims that Wacom owns, to make, have made, use, sell, import and distribute Compliant Implementations. If a licensee brings (or participates in the bringing of) any assertion, lawsuit or any other proceedings against Wacom or any other party claiming that a Compliant Implementation infringes an Essential Claim or any of the Essential Claims is invalid, Wacom may revoke the rights granted above to such licensee. Upon such revocation, such rights will be deemed to have never been granted.

No Warranty

The WILL Data Format Specification is provided to licensee “as is” and with all faults and defects without warranty of any kind. To the maximum extent permitted under applicable law, Wacom, on its own behalf and on behalf of its affiliates and its and their respective licensors, contractors and service providers, expressly disclaims all warranties, whether express, implied, statutory or otherwise, with respect to the WILL Data Format Specification and any updates or modification thereof, including all implied warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, title and non-infringement, and warranties that may arise out of course of dealing, course of performance, usage or trade practice. It is each licensee’s responsibility to periodically review the License and the WILL Data Format Specification for any such modifications or updates. Licensee’s subsequent use of the Licensed Materials following such updates or modifications shall be conclusively deemed an acceptance of all such updates or modifications. Definitions

“Compliant Implementation” means the portion of an application, product, or service that inputs, outputs and exchanges digital ink data compliant with the WILL Data Format Specification.

“Essential Claim” means a claim of a patent, whenever and wherever issued, that is necessarily infringed in order to achieve compliance with the requirements of the WILL Data Format Specification. A claim is necessarily infringed only when there is no reasonable way for Compliant Implementation to avoid infringement of that claim.

“WILL Data Format Specification” means any version of the WILL Data Format Specification published by Wacom. By way of example only, any specification not published by Wacom or that incorporates the WILL Data Format Specification by reference is not the WILL Data Format Specification for purposes of this license.
